9. 9/19/16 **PLEADINGS.** All amendments and supplements must be filed by this date. This order does not preclude prompt filing of pleadings directly responsive to any timely filed pleadings.

10. Tuesday of **PRE-TRIAL CONFERENCE OR DOCKET CALL.**
